

Verbs with Identical Tense Form in Present, Past and Past Participle Forms

-My Accident-

I was driving my motorbike one day, and a dog ran across the road in front of me.

To avoid killing him, I swerved and hit a fence.

When I **hit** the fence, I broke my leg and **cut** it open, so I let the doctor **put** some medicine on.

I told him to **quit** as it really **hurt** as he **set** the leg in a splint, but as he **spread** the wound, he told me to **shut** my mouth and stop crying. The treatment **cost** me an arm and a leg, and my dignity.

Example:

Everyday I hurt myself.
Yesterday, I hurt myself.
Have you hurt yourself again?
(Yes I have).

Contrast:

Everyday I eat breakfast.
Yesterday, I ate breakfast.
Have you eaten breakfast today?
(Yes I have).
