This statement is incorrect...everyone is creative, has imagination, a sense of fantasy, a spirit of inquiry and sense of wonder about life, the universe and everything-but you may have forgotten it, or left it somewhere when you were growing up, or you are no longer in touch with it.

As a free child, you had it, but then you became a reactive child; a child who adapted to the onerous demands placed on you by family, school and society...and you forgot...forgot your true self.

Isn't it time you rediscovered it again? How do you do this?

Well, you have to be a bit of a rebel...and most of us have forgotten how to rebel!
