
TALIGING ABOUT TIME

PAST
PRESENT
FUTURE



- 1. E to F = In one week's <u>time</u> (E) I will go to Taipei. A week <u>after that/later</u> (F), I will sit my exam there. [Because you are talking about a future-future, you can use "later" or "after that". For <u>normal future</u> as in "E", use "time"].
- 2. G to H = In 2 week's <u>time</u> (G), I will sit my exam in Taipei. One week <u>before that/earlier</u> (H), I will go there. [Because you are talking about a past-future, you can use "before (that)", even though you are in the future].
- 3. A to B = One week <u>ago</u> (A), I went to Kenting for a holiday. The week <u>before that</u> (B), I finished my exams. [Because you are talking about past-past, you can use "before". For <u>normal</u> past as in A, you use "ago"].
- 4. C to D = Two weeks \underline{ago} (C), I finished my exams. One week \underline{after} $\underline{that}/\underline{later}$ (D), I went to Kenting for a holiday. [Because you are talking about a future-past, you can use "later", even though you are in the past].
